Project name	Growing Together
Description	The project uses gardening as a tool to enable disadvantaged people to gain new skills, practical experience and qualifications for work while also improving mental health. The project will deliver a staged work journey from the point of engagement, moving people from long term unemployment into supported outdoor work experience and training programmes and onto employment or further training.
